OFF THE ROAD TYRE RPEIAR WORKMANSHIP & MATERIAL WARRANTY

This warranty specifically covers tyres repaired and sold by Specialised Tyre & Rubber Repairers.

WARRANTY

Every off the road tyre repair manufactured by Specialised Tyre & Rubber Repairers bearing the Specialised Tyres repair production code is guaranteed to be free from defects in workmanship and materials. This warranty applies to the following limited service life and application.

COMPENSATION

If a Specialised Tyres Repair fails and the failure reason is determined to be as a result of defects in workmanship or material within the nominated warranty, then Specialised Tyres, at its option will: -

- Credit an amount equal to the pro-rata value of the unachieved warranty (calculated by multiplying the tyre's repair purchase price by the percentage of the unachieved warranty), or
- Deduct the proportion of the unachieved value of the repair from the value of a replacement repair.
- Warranty settlement will not include the cost of tyre servicing, handling or transportation.

EXCLUSIONS AND LIMITATIONS

Damages as result of the following event are specifically excluded from this warranty:

- (i) Road hazard including cut, cut separation, penetration, impact burst, etc.
- (ii) Damages by electricity, excess heat (i.e. welding), fire, oil, grease or corrosive material
- (iii) Damage buy impact with any loading, servicing or handling equipment or by impact with other equipment during operation.
- (iv) Improper fitting to non standard rim or non approved rims or non standard mounting and demounting procedures.
- (v) Any mechanical damage due to defects in vehicle alignment, steering, suspension or any other mechanical defect which causes uneven wear or premature tyre failure.
- (vi) Repairs being applied in service applications outside the nominated application provided in the repair application guide.
